# BACKGROUND


- **China Lake, Edwards AFB, Fort Irwin apply for JLUS studies (2004)**
- **Office of Economic Adjustment funds joint study**
- **Study scope revised to include military operating area at installations and R-2508 Airspace**
- **CA Office of Research and Planning and Kern County serve as co-leads for project management**

# Purpose

---

**“Sustain the military mission and community economic development, safety and health” in our region.**

# R-2508 Airspace: JLUS Study Area



# OBJECTIVES

---

**Encourage collaborative planning between military installations and local jurisdictions to promote compatible land uses**

**Develop strategies to reduce impacts of existing community and military operations on each other**

# APPROACH

- **Identify Agency Participants**
- **Establish Technical and Advisory Working Committees**
- **Conduct survey to identify existing processes and issues**
- **Conduct local workshops**
- **Develop process recommendations and identify data gaps**

# Expected Outcomes

- **Improve communication between participants**
- **Identify issues and/or areas requiring further study**
- **Pursue supplemental funding to continue working on long-term solutions (tasks, people, \$, time)**
