

Habitat Restoration AWP FY03

- Began implementation of an AWP for the landscape-based restoration of the San Felipe Creek-San Sebastian Marsh watershed of Anza-Borrego Desert State Park (ABDSP) and El Centro Field Office (ECFO). The AWP is in draft and needs review by ABDSP and ECFO.
- Continue planning and host the Habitat Restoration Conference in Palm Springs next March.
- Continue to establish partnerships that benefit the DMG and the DMG partners. Market the DMG and the habitat restoration program.
- Continue working in with the Mojave Weed Management Area (MWMA). Assist MWMA in the development of a five-year strategic plan.
- Continue discusses with stakeholders and potential partners to conduct landscape-based restoration in the Amargosa and Mojave Rivers. Develop a strategic plan for management of the Amargosa River. Develop an AWP for restoration on both the Amargosa and Mojave.
- Continue to work with USGS in the RVDE review process. Provide guidance and recommendations on the program from the DMG as a whole. Evaluate the RVDE program and make recommendations.
- Assist DMG partners in the procurement of alternative funding for restoration projects.
