

Recommendations for DMG Funding of Illegal Dumpsites

1. The government portion of Nipton (\$75,000) should be fully funded because the dump is big, has high visibility and a partnership with the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) is in place.
2. The other dumps recommended for funding will allow for several smaller, highly visible accomplishments while promoting interagency DMG cooperation.
2. The Route 66 Sites should receive \$29,000 in DMG money unless other monies become available for this cleanup. If the government portion (\$106,000) of the Route 66 Sites cleanup were fully funded with DMG money all other work would be precluded.
3. Yucca Mesa and Sandy Valley may be allocated funds latter in the year pending a partnership and prevention solutions.
5. Vidal and Andre need more work and should be reconsidered next FY.
6. The committee felt that there were other, more cost effective methods to clean up the Tire Dump.
